

As Mayor and on behalf of the City of Chicago, I welcome you to the 2007 Annual Report for the Chicago Children's Advocacy Center (CCAC).



Facing the Problem

Each year, approximately 2,500 abused children walk through the doors of the Chicago Children's Advocacy Center – their average age is eight.

When abused children come to the CCAC, they immediately receive the services they so desperately need. The advocates provide case management and support for every family. Specially trained child sensitive forensic interviewers talk to the children and listen to their story. Mental health professionals provide immediate crisis intervention as well as long-term therapy. Working together as a child-centered team, the partners at the CCAC provide hope and healing to Chicago's abused children.

Joining Together to Find Solutions


Through coordinated efforts, staff from the Chicago Police Department, the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services, the Cook County State's Attorney's Office, and the Cook County Bureau of Health Services, work hand in hand to ensure the overall health, well-being and safety of each and every child that walks through the doors to the CCAC.

Healing Bodies

Many children who come to the Center require medical attention; that's why the CCAC has a state-of-the-art, child friendly medical clinic that specializes in caring for abused children. From conducting a non-invasive examination that includes an overall health check-up, to addressing parents' specific questions, to providing immediate access to the mental health staff, treatment at the medical clinic is a critical first step for these children and their families to begin the healing process.

Mending Minds

Long after the physical symptoms of abuse have subsided, the emotional impact remains. There is an immediate need to assess the mental health of an abused child, screening for depression, anxiety, posttraumatic stress disorder and suicidal tendencies. Based on their findings, the highly specialized mental health counselors at the CCAC implement a wide range of treatment including individual and group therapy, and innovative programs such as art therapy, to help children overcome the trauma of abuse.

lending a voice

A recent study of the effectiveness of the therapeutic treatment at the CCAC was released by the Juvenile Protection Association in August 2007. The report indicated that children who received mental health treatment at the CCAC made statistically significant improvement in their behavior and in child reported symptoms of posttraumatic stress and dissociation.

According to the findings, parents felt involved in setting treatment goals, felt that treatment was responsive to their children’s needs, and that their children were getting better as a result of mental health support.

Providing Safety

The CCAC is a safe haven for children and families who have been touched by abuse. The Illinois Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) works to ensure the child’s safety; the Chicago Police Department detectives lead the criminal investigation of the alleged perpetrator; and the Cook County State’s Attorney’s Office works to bring the offender to justice.

Lending a Voice

At the CCAC, no child’s cry goes unheard. A child can tell their story – one time, at one place – and all of the child welfare professionals that need to hear that story are in one building, working as a team to provide investigative and support services. With compassionate and caring follow up support, abused children can heal, living fuller and brighter lives.

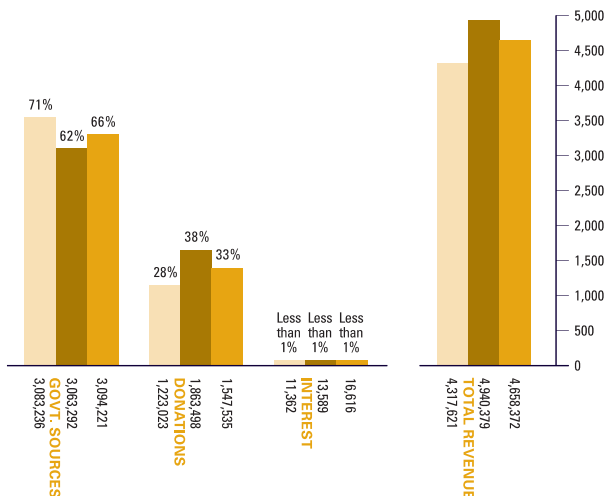

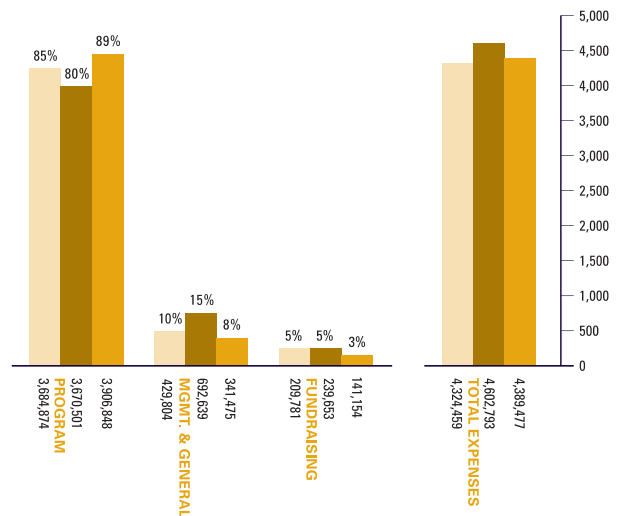
