ChicagoCAC offers education sessions for professionals, parents/caregivers, community members and front-line providers on preventing, recognizing, responding to and reporting sexual abuse. Each training is customized for the specific audience. Sessions are available online or in-person and can be facilitated in English or Spanish. Illinois continuing education units are available for licensed social workers, counselors and psychologists. Fees depend on audience, duration and delivery method.

- Impacts of trauma on individuals and communities
- Elements of resilience and trauma-informed environments

Keeping Children Safe for Caregivers *1-2hrs*

- Having appropriate conversations about abuse and safety
- Teaching body part names, healthy sexual development, boundaries, and consent
- Safety planning for your family to reduce risk of abuse

Keeping Children with Disabilities Safe *for Professionals or Caregivers* *1-2hrs*

- Creating family safety plans to prevent sex abuse
- How to talk to and protect children from abuse
- Identifying concerning behaviors in adults, teens, and children that may put them at risk of sexually abusing children

Human Trafficking Awareness for Children +12 *30-60 mins*

- Age-appropriate awareness presentations for students in middle school or high school
- Definition of human trafficking as well as signs to look for if a peer is being trafficked
- Includes information on texting and internet safety
